

Faith, Substance & Evidence (FSE) University – Scholarship Rules Date: January 10, 2019

In order to be eligible for the FSE University scholarship program, all four of the following requirements must be met. The candidate must sign this agreement (as described below) that they understand and will forfeit the scholarship if any one of these four requirements is not met.

#1. Read, understand and sign the FSE Statement of Faith.

#2. Purchase the FSE book for each of the four courses

There are 4 opportunities for a candidate to get a \$250 scholarship: one scholarship for each of the four courses:

- (1) Worldviews, Truth & Evidence
- (2) Origin of Man
- (3) The Reliability of the Bible and the Person of Jesus Christ
- (4) God's Will for My Life

Each of these courses has its own, unique book. Each book can be purchased from the Class Instructor at the beginning of each course, or if they wish go online at www.fse.life and order the book.

Each course usually runs anywhere from 6 weeks to 10 weeks, with each weekly class being approximately 1.5 hours long.

The book is essential to the class, as the material cannot be covered completely in the class, so it is up to the candidate/student to keep up with the reading.

#3. Attend at Least 80% of the weekly classes for each course

For each of the four courses described above, the candidate is eligible for the \$250 scholarship at the end of the classes provided their attendance shows they have attended at least 80% of the classes.

#4. Score at least 80% on the Final Exam

There will be a multiple choice open-book test handed out at the end of that course, that is specific to that course. The student/candidate will have ONE WEEK to complete the test and hand it in to the course instructor for grading. If the candidate does not hand in the test within one week, he or she forfeits the scholarship.
